THREE SHIRES MEDICAL PRACTICE - RECORD SHARING

There are currently 2 separate NHS initiatives regarding the way that information in your medical record is held and shared with other agencies. You may opt out of these schemes if you wish by completing the form below.

The new GDPR regulations govern how data is stored and shared. Your data is stored under the "Lawful Basis for Processing" under Articles 6 and 9 of the GDPR. You do not at present have the ability to opt out of having an NHS patient record, but you do have rights to access the data and correct inaccuracies.

1. Summary Care Record

This is a NATIONAL system that will take only medication and allergies, and main summary health information from your record so that information is available to clinicians if you are taken ill anywhere else in the country.

2. Connecting Care Record

This is a LOCAL system that will enable clinicians to look at the key information from your record e.g if you suffer from diabetes or a heart complaint. Information about this was on the back of the letter about the Summary Care Record. This data will be available to LOCAL Hospitals and local Out of Hours services, who may deal with you at any time in the future. It is currently a "viewing" only service –data is not uploaded en masse, but the hospital (with your permission at the time) would be able to bring up the summary page from your GP practice record.

This form will be scanned into your medical record, and your preferences coded after completion. May 2018
